## WHITE

Bordeaux Blanc 'Le Merle', Château Clarke, Listrac, France 2016 £39  
Sauvignon Blanc | Sémillon | Muscadelle | Sauvignon Gris

Le Merle was first produced back in the late 1800s and revived by in the 1970s by Baron Edmond de Rothschild. A ripe, round take on dry white Bordeaux from a village and region better known for reds.

Domaine de Villaine Bouzeron, Burgundy, France  2018 £49  
Aligoté

The 'other' white Burgundy grape - often overlooked, but this is a stunner from the co-director of the iconic Domaine de la Romanée-Conti. Flinty, textured, fresh and long - a great alternative to Chablis. 2018 was a warm year so brings additional roundness to the party.

Henschke 'Louis' Semillón, Eden Valley, Australia  2017 £52  
Semillón

Eden Valley Semillón is a fascinating style - naturally lower in alcohol, the wines are vibrant and crisply citrusy in their youth but as the wines age they take on a honeyed, waxy and smoky character that is dangerously moreish. Henschke are a traditional family-run estate, blessed with some of the oldest vines in Australia.

Terre Alte, Livio Felluga, Friuli, Italy  2016 £70  
Sauvignon Blanc | Pinot Blanc | Friulano

One of Italy's most prestigious white wines, first produced in 1981, this is exotic, intense and extremely complex - tropical, floral, honeyed and structured, it's crying out for food.

## RED

Tinta Barocca, Momento Wines, Swartland, South Africa  2019 £51  
Tinta Barocca

Tinta Barocca is usually found as a blending grape in sweet Port production, but in the right hands it can make dry, savoury and elegant wines more akin to deep Pinot Noir than Port.

Mareliese Niemann is certainly the right hands - part of a new wave of extremely talented young South African winemakers making world-beating wines from old vines in the heart of Swartland and Stellenbosch. Definitely one to try.

Château de Fonbel, St-Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France 2010 £64  
Merlot | Carmenere | Cabernet Sauvignon

Under the same ownership as the legendary Château Ausone, Fonbel make ever-reliable classic St-Emilion - plush and round in style, with concentrated dark fruit and a marked, but well-integrated, oak influence.

Château Corton Grancey Grand Cru, Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France 2012 £112  
Pinot Noir

Only produced in vintages where conditions are optimal, this is intense, powerful, concentrated Pinot Noir from Grand Cru vineyards only. The marked mint and liquorice notes provide a stylistic cross-over with many a Bordeaux.

Alter Ego de Château Palmer, 3ème Cru Classé, Margaux, France  2010 £143  
Cabernet Sauvignon | Merlot

Nominally the second wine from Palmer, Alter Ego usually is stylistically very different rather than a lighter-touch copy of the main Château production. This is big and bold - bags of espresso, tobacco and spice but plenty of sweet cassis and plum to support it all.
